Equities – prices looked down on BSE today registering heavy losses on continuous Bear selling and continuous bull liquidation and panic selling from financial institutions. The hike in passenger fares in Railway Budget and increase in the Corporate taxes by the Central Govt., dampened the mood of the market.

The Sensex initially opened at 27654.45 and rose to 27713.34 dropped to 27445.45 at the close of business session. Nifty also declined by 76.34 points. The following are the prices at glance of pivotal shares. A total of 24 scrips declined and 6 scrips rose.
