Rajasthan receives less rain than most other parts of India. Yet some areas of Rajasthan do not suffer from as severe water shortage as some of the rainier regions. People of Alwar district, for example, have learned water harvesting. They make storage tanks to collect roof water. They dig ponds. They build small check dams to slow down the flow of water in streams and rivers. Water then has more time to sink in to the soil and reach to the wells. They dig trenches on slopes to trap the water flowing down them. These trenches recover also the fertile topsoil that would otherwise be washed away by the rains. The winner of the Ramon Magsaysay award in 2001, Rajendra Singh, has been a pioneer of all this in the district of Alwar in Rajasthan.
