# SENSEX NOSE DIVES BY 654 POINTS ON SAUDI AIR STRIKES ON YEMEN AND DISCOURAGING RAIL BUDGET

Mumbai,March 12

Saudi Arabian air strikes against Yemen sparked off a risk aversion in financial markets. Crude oil prices shot up by 6% with prices reaching \$63 a barrel. Rail Budget also failed to inspire investors who were already shaken by fears of worsening EU debt crisis following poll stalemate in Italy.

In the Lok Sabha Railway Minister Pawan Kumar Bansal hiked freight tariff of less than five per cent, effective from April  $1^{\rm st}$  this year.

"There was nothing exciting in the budget and the freight rate hike could push up prices," said Pankaj Pandey, Head Research, ICICI direct.

Profit-booking on the expiry of February series on Thursday also weighed on the market, traders said.

Realty, PSU, Refinery, Metal, Power, Capital Goods and Healthcare sectors declined sharply on profit-booking, while Consumer Durable, IT and Tech sectors firmed up on good buying enquiries.

Small-cap and Mid-cap shares also declined sharply by 5.63 percent and 4.36percent, respectively, on panic selling triggered by speculation that pledged holdings are being sold.

The BSE benchmark Sensex resumed higher at 28,365 and moved in a wide range of 28,011 and 27,893 before ending at 27711, a net loss of 654 points or 2.33%.

The NSE 50-share Nifty also dropped by 189 points or 2.21% to end at 8342. It fell by 354.95 points or 5.84% in the last five weeks.

Banking stocks suffered heavy losses on liquidity concerns in banking system after government set target for gross market borrowing at Rs 6.29 trillion this fiscal.

The sentiment turned bearish on hike in some taxes despite reduction in Securities Transaction Tax on mutual fund and equity futures transactions.

Auto stocks, including Maruti, saw losses as government announced hiking excise duty on luxury cars and their parts.

24 scrips out of 30-share Sensex finished in red while only six ended in green.

Major losers from the Sensex pack were Hindalco India (695)645, Tata Steel (645)612, Reliance Industries Ltd. (458)414, HDFC Bank (246)221, Coal India (865)814, SBI (958)935, DR Reddy's Lab (358)331,ICICIBank (478)438, Cipla (950)911,ONGC (1274)1198, HDFC (934)903, Gail India (365)346 and Larsen & Tubro (967)946.

However, TCS rose by 24 points closing at Rs. 934 followed by Infosys 21 points ending at Rs. 876, Wipro by 18 points closing at 658 and Bajaj Auto by 15 points closing at 567
